E-LEARNING COURSES

- 1. In academic year 2019/20 the following e-learning courses are available for students at University of Wroclaw:
 - a) Computer Intensive Methods (the easiest course, prerequisites: *Podstawy statystyki praktycznej* lub *Teoria statystyki*)
 - b) **Survival Analysis** (prerequisites: *Modele liniowe* + (*Teoria statystyki* lub *Wnioskowanie statystyczne*))
 - c) Bayesian Data Analysis
 (the most demanding course,
 prerequisites: Modele liniowe + (Teoria statystyki lub Wnioskowanie statystyczne))
 - d) Semiparametric Regression prerequisites: Modele liniowe + (Teoria statystyki lub Wnioskowanie statystyczne)) recommended: Zaawansowane modele liniowe
- 2. Courses (a)–(c) are offered by Hasselt University, course (d) is offered by University of Wroclaw.
- 3. In order to enroll in course (a), (b) or (c) students from University of Wroclaw need:
 - a) Preregister, preferably by Oct 1st (Tuesday), but no later than Oct 7th (Monday) at www.uhasselt.be/admission (details below).
 Preregistration is not binding, but required to follow courses at Hasselt University.
 Preregistration is already open.
 - b) Register at USOS (Wroclaw) by Oct 3rd, 12.30 pm (after this deadline, paper registration will be available by Oct 7th (Monday)).
 - c) Students will be granted access to the courses on the Blackboard system as soon as possible, but not later than October 9th (Wednesday). Early preregistration will allow early access to the course.
- 4. In order to enroll in course (d) students from University of Wroclaw only need to register at USOS (Wroclaw) by Oct 3rd, 12.30 pm (after this deadline, paper registration will be available by Oct 7th (Monday)).
- 5. Students can drop any e-learning course by **November 4th**. In order to drop the course students of Wroclaw need both:
 - a) Deregister at Hasselt University (details below).
 - b) Deregister (in paper) at Wroclaw University.
- 6. Every e-learning course has on-line consultation sessions (Question and Answer sessions), see http://www.math.uni.wroc.pl/studia/plany_zajec/planZ.php. Attending the consultation sessions should be treated as **obligatory** for all the students enrolled in the course.
- 7. We strongly encourage students to preregister at Hasselt as soon as possible, as the first consultation session in scheduled on **Oct 3rd**.

Pre-registration at Hasselt:

Students register for the master of statistic at the website - www.uhasselt.be/admission. Students need to do a minimal pre-registration and need to register for the academic year 2019-20 as a 'interuniversity guest' and choose the programme "Interuniversity guest statistics (from abroad)", fill out identity data (incl. address), secondary education (mark 'Other' at "I obtained my secondary/high school diploma' and then fill out the data of the relevant institution) and then higher education (mark "Other" for "Region of education" and then fill out the current/last study); no uploads of documents are required. De-registration at Hasselt:

In order to drop the course at Hasselt, students need to deregister for that course. The student selects at the UHasselt homepage "Student", selects the "My academic file" application, selects in the left menu "My programme" followed by "Unsubscribe study programme or course unit". Then a personalized pdf will be generated, listing all currently subscribed courses of the student at UHasselt.
